Your detailed itinerary

DAY 1 ● NICE

Upon arrival in Nice, you will collect your bags, and a shuttle will drive you to the Club Med Opio Resort.

DAY 2 ● NICE

This morning, meet your guide for a full-day tour of Nice, the capital of the French Riviera. Start with a drive along the iconic Promenade des Anglais, lined with prestigious hotels like the grand Negresco. Explore the narrow streets and squares of the Old Town, admiring the baroque Cathédrale Sainte-Réparate and vibrant markets like Cours Saleya. End with free time at Place Masséna, featuring the impressive Fontaine du Soleil and the statue of Apollo.

DAY 3 ● SAINT-PAUL-DE-VENTE

Take a scenic drive to Saint-Paul-de-Vence, one of the oldest medieval towns on the French Riviera. Perched between the Alps and the Mediterranean, this picturesque village is famous for its art museums like the Maeght Foundation, showcasing works by renowned 20th-century artists such as Chagall and Miró. Stroll through its charming narrow streets and explore the many art galleries and local boutiques.

DAY 4 ● CANNES | LERINS ISLANDS

Meet your guide for a tour of Cannes, known for its luxury, yacht-filled harbor, and Film Festival. Stroll along La Croisette, visit the historic Le Suquet district for stunning views of the Bay of Cannes, and explore its rich history. After lunch, sail to the Lérins Islands, including Île Saint-Honorat and Île Sainte-Marguerite, home to Fort Royal, where the mysterious Man in the Iron Mask, an unidentified prisoner of state during the reign of King Louis XIV, was imprisoned.

DAY 5 ● ANTIBES

Discover Antibes, the second-largest town on the French Riviera and home to Europe's largest luxury marina. Stroll along the pier at Port Vauban to admire heritage boats and yachts, then enter the old town through the ramparts to explore medieval cobblestone streets. Visit the 12th-century Château Grimaldi, now the Picasso Museum, and conclude your day at Cours Masséna, where you can browse the vibrant Provençal Market filled with local produce, cheeses, and spices.

DAY 6 ● EZE | MONACO

This morning, meet your guide to visit the medieval village of Èze, perched 1,401 feet above sea level with stunning views of the French Riviera. Stroll through its charming cobbled streets and admire the stone houses. Next, explore Monaco, where you can see landmarks like the serene Saint Martin gardens and the Cathédrale Notre-Dame-Immaculée, the resting place of Grimaldi royals. Enjoy free time in the old town for lunch before heading to the iconic Casino of Monte Carlo.

DAY 7 ● GRASSE

Today, visit Grasse, the perfume capital of the world, nestled in the hills above Cannes among fields of jasmine, roses, and lavender. Perfume production began here in the Middle Ages, evolving from leather tanning after a local tanner created scented gloves that captivated Queen Catherine de' Medici. Tour the Fragonard Perfume factory to learn about perfume-making, then stroll through the town's vibrant streets to see landmarks like the 13th-century Notre Dame Cathedral and the bustling Place aux Aires market.

DAY 8 ● RETURN HOME

Today, a shuttle will transport you to Nice International Airport for your departure flight home.
